Wattman Trains and Trams has recently expanded and moved to its modern facility located in the city of Granby in Québec. The company manufactures electrically powered vehicles that are pollution free, silent, manoeuvrable and safe. Inspired by the nineteenth-century designs and crafted with the best materials each vehicle type provides a unique experience.

We offer 2 types of vehicles.

### The Mini Express

The Mini Express is the ideal Train for parks and attractions. Being trackless there is no need to build an expensive rail system. It's handling and small turning radius make it ideal for Shopping Centers, Zoos, Theme Parks, Amusement Parks, Party Rentals, Festivals and Fairs as well as neighbourhood events. The low maintenance and operation costs offer a quick payback that increases the attractiveness of owning a Wattman Mini Express. Because of its small turning radius, the train can be operated indoors as well as outdoors. It has 15-20 hours of autonomy and can carry up to 24 children. Adults can also ride.

### The Tram Express

The Tram Express offers the same feel, look and superior craftsmanship as the train. Parks, Zoos malls and Theme Parks see this as an attractive people mover of shuttle that enhances significantly the visitor experience. The Tram Express also addresses the need to provide environmentally friendly transport for the growing markets of leisure communities, large hotel complexes and 'lifestyle centers'. The motorized has a seating capacity of 12 while the passenger wagon that is hitched in the rear seat 14. When combined, the tram has autonomy of 15 hours.
